Life is made of decisions, today we are the fruit of what we decided to do yesterday. If we want a better future Decide today for the best: God.

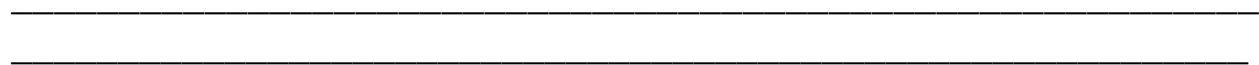

## **2. The importance of repentance. 8:40am(30mins)**

*Acts 3:19 "19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord.*

**Repentance:** Comes from the Greek word Metanoia which means thought or way of thinking, change is also, change of attitude, thus returning to the original state of the glory of God in man.

*Romans 12:2 <sup>2</sup> And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.*

Repentance is the step to enter the Kingdom of God. It is to have a deep conviction to accept and acknowledge that we lived far from the love and the covering of God.

Repentance begins because the Holy Spirit convinces us of sin, and produces the conviction of what is the path that we must walk.

*<sup>8</sup> And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: John 16:8*

So, repentance is to return to the target or original Attention of God, to live under Government or Lordship of Christ, and have a knowledge direction to the divine purpose. This brings a change of thinking, gives us clear objective to the natural things, and when we reached this knowledge through the word of God, we get the power to achieve a new way of living and a change integral of life.

From this we learn that the word urges us to repent, the Holy Spirit convicts us and guides us; but the true repentance is the decision of a change of attitude which is taken after having received the word.

### **Repentance is a Mandate**

For a long time God forgave those who did all that, because they did not know what they were doing; But now God commands that all who inhabit this world repent, and obey him only.

*30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent: Acts 17:30*

When the word is speaking of repentance, It is not speaking of remorse; remorse is not of the spirit, but is a fruit of the soul, repentance is of the spirit. When we repent, it manifests itself as new nature, that He recreated in us, the fruit of the spirit. Repentance is a signal that activates the inherent power that is within us.”

### **What should we repent from?**

- Of our Past lives, which was in contrary of God word for us.
- Of our sins
- Of our rebellions ( Disobedience)
- Of our human way of thinking.

### **Result of repentance: Conversion**

Conversion means, progressively changing something or and someone in the opposite direction of the original state. It is the process in which we will change be produced by God, in our lives.

It is a process of change of the person in all your: spirit, soul and body, and this change is progressive, not momentary. It is the process of

perfectionism of the work which God began in us to take us to be who we are.

***6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ: Philippians 1:6***

***In the Scriptures is the effect that accompanies the new or birth in God, a return to God.***

***9 For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God; 1 Thessalonians 1:9***

Conversion is the process where the new believer is receiving strength, acquiring new knowledge, abandoning ignorance and is formed to be a leader who will do the same with others. It's to turn completely from the way we walk, it has to do with an attitude, believe the word and assume the responsibility for the new life in God.

### **Prayer of Repentance**

Lord, you have endured me all these years with my sins, but nonetheless You pitied me;

I was led astray in every way, but now I will sin no more; I have wronged You and I have been unjust; I will be so, no more; I renounce sin, I renounce the Devil, I renounce iniquity that stains my soul; free my soul from all that is against Your holiness;

I entreat You, Lord, to rescue me from all evil; Come Jesus now, come now and abide in my heart;

Forgive me, Lord, and allow me to rest in You, For You are my Shield, my Redeemer and my Light and in You do I trust;

From today I will bless You Lord at all times;

I repudiate evil and all other gods and idols, for You are the Most High over the world, far transcending all other gods;

By Your mighty arm, rescue me from ill health, rescue me from being a captive, rescue me from trouble and defeat my enemy the Devil; come quickly to my help O Saviour!

Amen!!

**Profetic Act: (20 mins)**

List of sins (the Cross): Before beginning this topic should have printed out the list of sins, these are called "clinics of sins" after this topic it will be distributed to each penielist a "clinic of sins", where each one mark in a box the sins committed. This clinic will be delivered folded and on the outside will have the name of each Penielist. It is advisable to take a few minutes to inquire if there is any doubt about the sins of the list. After each Penielist have filled the list they will put it in a basket in front of the cross, while they are worshipping and without noticing someone will change the basket by one containing papers folded in a similar way with the name of each Penielist , but within this blank only with the quotation of Isaiah 53:4-5. (one for each participant in the Peniel).

Then it will be called by name a volunteer to pass to the front and will be given his sheet to read in public all his sins. The participant will go to the front and take his sheet but you is asked not to read it, so that is given the opportunity for other participants to take their sheet, they will also be asked not to read until instructed.

When everyone has their sheet they will ask the volunteer to read his or her aloud and then they will tell all the participants that they can read theirs, after this, the environment is prepared to minister forgiveness to all people.

### 3. THE POWER THE FORGIVENESS 10:45 am (30 mins)

*Genesis 41: 50-52 50 Before the years of famine came, two sons were born to Joseph by Asenath daughter of Potiphera, priest of On.  
51 Joseph named his firstborn Manasseh[e] and said, “It is because God has made me forget all my trouble and all my father’s household.”  
52 The second son he named Ephraim[f] and said, “It is because God has made me fruitful in the land of my suffering.”*

If we want to enjoy a full life with Christ, we have to understand that our personal tastes and desires no longer play, nor play, any role in our decisions. So, the first thing we must understand is that we must be strong to extend forgiveness, because forgiveness is not normal, the normal thing nowadays is to hate and keep resentment. Weak people not only do not forgive but seek revenge, but strong people have the strength of God to extend forgiveness.

1.- The lack of forgiveness stops many things in our lives.

How do I know that God has forgiven me?

Why do not I feel that? How do I know that I have forgiven if I do not know if I have done it well?

1.1.- Let us study this aspect in the life of Joseph who had to deal with hatred, with bitterness, and then extend forgiveness to his brothers, and that is why Joseph remained as an example of Christ.

1.2.- The names of the two sons of Joséph were:



Manasseh[e], which means "the one that makes you forget". In v51 the expression is: "God made me forget all that I have suffered in my parents' house." And Ephraim[f] that means fruitful.

1.3.- In these names of the two sons of Joseph, this is one of the most powerful teachings: if you have the capacity to forgive and forget, you will bear fruit where everyone thought you would never get ahead, because forgiveness brings fruition.

Josephs children are born before the first year of the famine that he had said, that is to say in the middle of the seven years of abundance, but it had already happened between 20 and 22 years that he had been sold by his brothers to some Midianite merchants, and these to Egypt.

2 .- Break with the strong holds that are nested in thoughts ,exp, " what they did to me is too serious"

2.1.- Let's see 22 years ago in Genesis 37. In this chapter the things are heating up as time goes on, and when the end of the chapter arrives we already have a big mess: Joséph is already sold, his brothers have already placated their anger, they will have thought about the mistake they made by lying to their father, but it was too late for that, his father will now live with the torment of guilt for more than 20 years, saying: its my fault, my son is dead.

2.2.- Joséph undoubtedly was not a perfect being and needed to be processed by the Lord in order to be ready for the dreams he dreamed; and the process was that God used the hatred of his brothers towards Joseph and take him to the dreams that God gave him.

Joseph was used in Potiphar's house and was put in jail for doing the right thing. Genesis 39

2.2.1.- When you have the nature of the Lord and you know that you are prosperous in your spirit, where ever you are, everything you do will prosper in your hands. V5

2.2.2.- V10 Joséph fled that day because he knew he had to please God, not because of the fear that they would discover him.

2.2.3.- V20 That Joseph has been put in jail and not killed, it is a miracle of God, since at that time Potiphar could have killed him since it was the custom in those days, and also Joseph was his property therefore no one was going to say anything.

2.3 .- That's why the Bible says, do not avenge, "Mine is revenge, I'll pay" God always knows how to deliver the righteous from the hour of tribulation, God always has a way out that you do not expect.

When you walk with God even in prison you can prosper. V23

3. No matter how many reasons you have for something, God is thinking of something better for you

.

3.1.- There are people who live bitter with God because of what has happened to them. Never question your today, because you do not know what God is doing; the big thing you are asking know that he has legally granted it to you, but since he is more interested in you, he will work with your life so that you will be able to manage what he has already reserved for you.

3.1.1.- Joseph could've been bitter for what his brothers did, be in bitterness for having been unjustly condemned for attempted rape, could have been in bitter with God because he did the right thing and feared God and God seemed unfair because he did not defend him.

3.2.- Joséph Spent time in prison and had the company of two characters. Genesis 40

3.2.1.- When he interprets the dream to the cupbearer, Joséph asks the cupbearer for help in v14, but in v23 he forgets Joséph. The interpretation was from God, but Joseph sees the opportunity and asks the cupbearer for help, seeking an extra favor apart from God's.

3.2.2.- Any of us would act in the same way, and that is the reason why disappointment arrives in our lives, because we expect something from a person and then when we do not do it we are disappointed.

3.3.- Joseph wanted to get out of prison, God wanted Joseph out of prison, but if the cupbearer had done him the favor, thus paying favor with favor, Joseph would have come out of prison and God's purpose would not have been fulfilled, because Joséph was going to go out to the good, to the adventure, to see what he does, but the purpose would have been there and what would have been of his dreams?

3.3.1.- The delays that happen to us in life can actually be part of the divine plan, that's why the Bible says: do not get excited, wait on the Lord and wait on him.

3.4.- Joseph needed to be totally delivered from the bitterness and self-pity that followed him and that we see in v15.

The apparent delays are because God wants to save us from blessings crushing us.

3.4.1.- Joseph spent two more years in prison, receiving the treatment of the Lord, Even though the butler forgot about him, when we are in the

hands of God, He will make Pharaoh dream a dream of which only you will have the interpretation.

3.4.2.- God has mysterious ways to bless us, that is why Solomon says that it is better to dominate the spirit than to take a city, because as a city without a walls and has its fences down, thus is the man whose spirit has no rein.

4.- Joseph is taken from prison to the palace. Chap. 41

When you manipulate and do things for your abilities, all you get is "a little load", when you let God act, God puts you up where you should be and not where you think you should be. Genesis 41: 39-44.

4.1.- Joseph's dream was fulfilled beyond what he believed, because not only his twelve brothers but a whole nation bowed before him. What you dream is only a part of what God has for you.

4.2.- Joseph publicly expressed what happened in his inner world in those two final years in prison, he said: in prison when the cupbearer forgot about me I also forgot about my anguish, about all the pain I felt so what my brothers did to me,

4.2.1.- That is why my first child will have a name that will remind me that I am not placed to remember the past and hate but to forget and forgive.

4.2.2.- And his second son brought him to fruition because he said on this earth God is going to make me fruitful.

5.- Now let's get into things that are key for us.

Joseph said:

There is no bitterness or pain for my past, I am fruitful in my present by letting go of my past.

5.1.- Let's go back to the questions, how do I know that I have really forgiven? How do I know that I have received forgiveness? How to act when the past that you have declared forgotten is presented to you in your triumphant today?

5.1.1.- In chapter 42 of Genesis, Joseph meets his brothers and Joseph's begins dealings with them, because one thing is when you have forgotten the past and another thing is when the past is present in your victory today; How are you going to act ?, Are you going to run away ?, Are you going to come out with a mallet to kill ?, Are you going to go out to embrace it ?, Or are you going to do things in a process?

5.1.2.- That is the great test, when you have in your hands the power to destroy all that did something to you. Because there you have the great opportunity to make them feel miserable, mock them, yell at their faces all your pain from the past and show them your great success.

5.1.3.- But if you did, it would be exposed that you are not different from them, and you would show that God lost his time with you, because we are expected to be different.

6.- How did Joseph manifest himself to his brothers and offer them total forgiveness?

The answer is in chapter 45 of Genesis.

6.1.- V1 To extend forgiveness, he made sure that no stranger was present that had nothing to do with what he was going to talk about.

6.1.1.- He did this because he did not want Egypt to know what his brothers did 22 years ago, otherwise they would have been hated in all of Egypt and he'd rather them being honored as his family. That is what Christ does with us, when He forgives you, He is not publishing it to embarrass you.

6.1.2.- That is why when Christ presented himself to his disciples who had abandoned him, before Peter who had denied him, he went through the door and only with them said "peace to you". When God forgives you, you do not tell the whole universe but he forgets, that is why we are expected to do when we extend forgiveness because there is a morning of glory that awaits us. That is the quality of forgiveness that God gives.

6.2.- V2-4 Joseph revealed his identity to his brothers in deep compassion and tears, because if he had said it from power he would have intimidated them completely.

6.2.1.- That we should do, like the Lord, like Joseph, that people feel respect, feel that you are compassionate, do not feel intimidated. You know that you have truly forgiven when you extend forgiveness and compassion.

6.2.2.- Joseph acted like this so that they would approach him and be able to embrace them, that is what Christ does, this is the Lord, he says that we must run to the throne of grace to find mercy, we tend to flee like Adam who looked for leaves from the fig tree, but we must be like David who ran to the heart of God and to the arms of the Father.

6.3.- V4-5 Joseph wished that they would now forgive themselves. Joseph knew that they felt guilty, that they lived with the torment of guilt for 22 years, that is why they said, this happens to us because of what we did (Genesis 42:22).

6.3.1.- It is time to forgive yourself. It is time to receive forgiveness but also to apply it to our own life because the Lord is merciful.

6.4.- V6-8. Joseph takes them out of all guilt and lets them see that it was a matter of God and not theirs. When you forgive like that, your future is a great victory because you can not spend your whole life dragging the past.

6.5.- V9-11. Joseph never looked back, looked at what is coming and how he was going to act.

6.5.1.- Joseph guided them to face the fear of telling Jacob what they did, a fact of the past they did not have to remind the old man, because it was one thing for Joseph's brothers to rejoice to be in his presence, but another very different was the torment of telling the father that they were 22 years old lying to him and that this is the reason why he was 22 years without being happy, crying every day. They were exposed to being cursed by their father. But the sins that God has forgiven you in the past do not have to be exhibited again in the present, because that has already been buried. What is left at the foot of the cross does not have to be exposed again.

6.5.2.- The past is tormenting for many, there are people who can not function in the present because they live remembering their past. Joseph told them, the past is behind, it does not have to be bitter to my dad, but now a new time has arrived.

6.6.- V24-28 Enough! I have been forgiven, and I have completely forgiven.

6.6.1.- His father never knew what his children did, it was his brothers that after he died Israel told Joseph your father sent to tell you to forgive

us for what we has done, but in reality Israel never found out because if he had not said it himself, because there are people who are still tormented by the past, because they have him nested inside.

7.- That is why we have to say: ENOUGH

7.1 .- Israel took his pain and his fault 22 years, this represents 8,030 days, 197,720 hours. That's why his scream was Enough! Jacob expressed his deep pain by not believing that it was not true that his son was alive, that is why he says he was distressed, because when we believe the lie, when the guilt torments us, you think there is no way out for you, and that is a lie of the darkness, when we believe the lie we begin to live by it.

7.2.- But Jacob could hear over the pain, the guilt, the torment of the past, the words of Joseph, this is the day you have to listen to the voice of who has saved you, because God so loved the world who has given his only begotten son for you, so that you do not be lost but have eternal life, you have to remember that with eternal love God has loved you and that we do not have the right to live questioning yesterday or bothering other peoples life with that but know this is a new time.

7.3.- V27. This is a time to be moved, we are on days that do not resemble any other in our lives.

7.3.1.- There are many cars, but there is one that is waiting for you, because your celebration time has come because you know that you have been forgiven and you have completely forgiven, that I can start a new time.

7.4.- That is why Jacob expressed this word Enough!



7.4.1.- Enough of the pain, enough of the guilt, enough of the sadness, enough of the bitterness, Joseph my son lives and I will go to see him before it is too late.

7.4.2.- The pain may have persecuted you for 10 years, 20 years, but a day of God's favor changes everything, that is why Jacob said enough, because the thoughts tormented him for 22 years, because the guilt gnawed him inside.

7.4.3.- Enough, I have been forgiven, and I have the power to extend forgiveness, because I will run to my increase (Joseph is increase), it will come to my life, because days begin in my life like no other, I'll do it now before it's too late.

7.5.- The love of Christ, forgiveness, is what makes the life of the kingdom, be different, live in the strength of forgiveness, live forgiven by God and extend grace and favor to those who have hurt you, that is not for normal people, it's for spiritual people.

### **Activity (30 mins)**

Act of writing and burning: The video "Rob Bell's Luggage" and then each participant will be given a blank sheet to write on the one hand the names of the people who abused or hurt them, and on the other hand the names of those they hurt. A declaration of forgiveness will be made with all penielists while each participant lifts the paper in his hand. Then each paper will be placed in a pot and they will be taken outdoors to burn all the papers in the pot, thus representing that the lack of forgiveness has been eradicated completely from the hearts.

#### 4. INIQUITY 1:00pm (45mins )

*17 Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. 18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as [a]by the Spirit of the Lord. 2 Corinthians 3:17-18*

*31 Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, “If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. 32 And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.” John 8:31-32*

We must identify cycles that want to repeat every time in our lives. If you repeat something every once in a while without looking for it, then it is time to reflect, because deliverance is needed.

Any evil bondage has its origin in sin, it is practiced in ignorance or disobedience with respect to the truth of God.

When you do not know the word of God you end up doing things you never wanted to do, and always the result is sadness and pain.

A person born in a environment of fight and arguments ends up being conflicted. A person surrounded by a drug and alcohol environment will be vicious.

A person who lives in the midst of sexual disorder will be depraved. Same with money.

This is not changed with human efforts but knowing the true love of God, which is what frees us from all bondage.

There are people who believe that it cuts the curses with changing city, but even if you move from country, if you are not liberated, the curse will manifest itself at some point.

I.-We must recognize and renounce inherited curses:

1.-Curses of the Earth: they are anti-God customs that have the peoples (they are part of their culture) of which we need to liberate ourselves in order to prosper and be happy.

There are countries that in economic resources are stronger than others, but their men and women live in societies without values or principles, immoralities, sexual disorder, abortions, among others.

There are cultures where peoples are bound to conflict, street disorders, violence, wars; and other cultures that exist that are distinguished by being slaves or living under the dominion of others.

There are towns in which their inhabitants are bound to pain, separation and divorce. This is what we call a curse of the earth!

What kind of evil habits should you reject?

Reject divorce and family conflicts.

Reject poverty, misery and debts.

Reject drugs and alcoholism.

Reject family feuds.

Reject the curse of hereditary disease.

Reject sudden death or accidents.

Reject the codes of slavery.

He refuses to live with sorrows and anguish.

Reject the spirit of cowardice and fear.

Reject discouragement and laziness.

2.-The Curse of bad concepts and bad examples of my parents.

"The main builders of destiny of the children are the parents" we are currently ninety percent of what our parents have ministered to us. Parents are direct ministers of our lives, every word and every example formed the main basis of what we are today, but we are not obliged to copy all the examples of our parents, we should not follow models of family anti-peace.

Everything is a chain, our parents were not taught how to educate and train for success and prosperity, and made many mistakes with us, so we must renounce the roots of poverty, pain, suffering, sickness, divorce, strife, Family crises; And not to keep repeating the mistakes made, but to get all curses cut from us and generate blessings for our children and the children of our children.

You must break with the false adoration of your parents: Some parents visited warlocks, sorcerers and great centers of idolatry or belonged to idolatrous religions and this affects until the third and fourth generation.

All the anti-Biblical adoration that our ancestors have practiced, brings many curses and therefore it is necessary to renounce.

You must break every hereditary curse; Just as medical science recognizes that hereditary diseases exist, strife, loss of children, accidents and loss of good business are also inherited.

3.-The self-curses are those bondages and spiritual ligatures that we ourselves get bound by our confessions and actions in attitude of rebellion, and we were imprisoned in them. (Psalm 32:5-6; James 3:6).

Words of bondage for those who are no longer with us:

"I can't live Without You".

"With another I will never be happy".

"Without you I'd rather be dead".

"If you let me not love anyone else"



"If you leave me I swear that I kill or I kill you."

Other types of auto curses:

Visits to witches or sorcerers, followers of the reading of horoscopes, to those who read the hands or throw the luck.

Robbery or dishonest earnings.

All kinds of sexual disorder: adultery, fornication, homosexual experiences, animal-binges.

Words of rebellion against the parents and against all kinds of authority.

II.-Christ liberated us from all these curses (Galatians 3:13-14)

When we believe in Jesus Christ and remain in him the power of the curse is broken in our lives, Christ carried all the curses of mankind on the Cross (v13) "accursed all that is Hung on a tree. "

When people turn their backs on Jesus, they do not believe or obey the word of God, they cannot enjoy the deliverance that God offers, on the contrary they suffer the curses that we have already spoken because they discarded the grace and the gift of salvation.

We must understand that for us to activate the power of blessing in our lives and families we must live by faith in the Word of God (Galatians 3:9,14; Ephesians 1:3)

The Fruit of faith is obedience to the word of God that causes the effects of blessing to be seen in our lives obtained by the sacrifice of Christ.

These blessings will be seen in your life if you determined to remain in Christ:

- God's blessings will follow you (Deuteronomy 28:2).
- You will be blessed in every place you are (Deuteronomy 28:3).

- Blessed are thy sons and thy lineage (Deuteronomy 28:4).
  - Blessed are your Journeys (Deuteronomy 28:6).
  - You will have the blessing of Victory (Deuteronomy 28:7).
  - You will have blessings in your businesses and negotiations (Deuteronomy 28:8).
  - All will see the blessings of believing and serving Jesus (Deuteronomy 28:10).
  - You will have wealth of goods and finances (Deuteronomy 28:11).
  - You'll live with open skies, "Heaven will be in your favor" (Deuteronomy 28:12).
  - You will have the blessing to govern and to lead (Deuteronomy 28:13).
  - You will never have debts, rather lend to many (Deuteronomy 28:12).
  - You will have spiritual blessings and riches (Ephesians 1:3).
- III.-How to function in freedom? Train your language with the truth,  
YOU SHOULD NEVER SAY:
- I can't, because "Christ gives me strength to face all kinds of situations." Philippians 4:13
  - I have No strength, for the Bible says, my God, I love you because you give me strength! Psalm 18:1
  - I cannot succeed economically, I was born to be poor; For "From his wonderful riches my God will give you, through Jesus Christ, all that you need." Philippians 4:19
  - I am alone; For Jesus Christ said: I will not leave you orphans, John 14:18, left the Holy Spirit to be with us forever.

- God does not hear me, God says "call me and I will answer you. I'll make you know wonderful and mysterious things you've never known. " Jeremiah 33:3
- I am afraid: Because the spirit that God has given them does not enslave or make them afraid. On the contrary, the spirit makes us children of God and allows us to call God: "Father!" Romans 8:15
- I was born to suffer, because your life is written by the Anointing of God, the thoughts that God has for you are good and not evil. He says, "always be joyful." "Rejoice in the Lord always"

Consolidate what has been given to you. This means plucking the bad and building the good in your life (Philippians 4:8-9).

Do your best to win God's approval. Thus, God will approve you as a worker who has nothing to be ashamed of, and who teaches the true message correctly. 2a Timothy 2:15

Look for his direction daily through prayer: Do not start any day without first put it in His hands, ask the Holy Spirit to guide you, teach you to live under the will of your heavenly Father and always pray what God says about You , not what doubts are dictating to your destiny.

The effective prayer of the righteous can much. "Elijah was a man subject to passions similar to ours, and he prayed fervently that he would not rain, and it did not rain on Earth for three years and six months. And again he prayed, and the sky gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit. " James 5:16-18. RVR60

### ACTIVITY (15 mins)

Letter of resignation: Each Penielist will be given a sheet with declarations of resignation towards the most common sins and curses, after having made all the declaration out loud voice, they will break the paper and trample it representing that since that day they shall be in



Control and no more sin will trample upon them, and them practice deliverance.

## PRACTICAL PRACTICES TO MINISTER DELEVERANCE

1. We must minister deliverance after having preached on the different types of bondage, inviting people to come to the front.
2. Ask those who are aware that they are linked to some of the ties that were named; And then begin to declare deliverance from all bondage to poverty, sorcery, Santeria, witchcraft, family curses. (We put in there hands a list of renunciation sentences so that the participants of the meeting can repeat).
3. Remember that all demonic rebuke or deliverance is done in the name of Jesus.

None of those who minister deliverance should have or be afraid of the manifestations of demons.

## 5. FAMILLIES WITH PURPOSE 2:41pm (34mins)

**( Before this preaching play the video “Flames of Love”-11min)**

So that we can fully study and understand what a purposeful family is, we need to have clear concepts family and purpose.

Family: A group of consanguineous persons or relatives who are created and reproduced within a framework of unity, and which are an important and vital part of a society.

Purpose: It is the will of God in Man, with man and for man, it is not an emotional state, or merely a desire, but a generational worldview with eternal meaning.

How is the family framed in the purpose of God? By father, mother and children; There is no other way neither divine nor natural for the creation of a family.

Man was created by God (Genesis 1:27). Then God took the woman out of the man's Rib (Genesis 2:22). The two, one flesh (Genesis 2:24) procreated children according to the divine purpose.

- The man represents from the beginning the head of the Family (1CORINTIOS11:3) (Ephesians 5:23).
- Women are the ideal aid for man (Genesis 2:18).
- Man and woman are a single flesh to cohabit and raise lineage (Genesis 2:24).
- The children are created for the extension, and through that same cycle, to exercise generational dominion over the Earth.

Divine Order:



That order is unalterable because they are principles framed in the divine vision. If someone tries to alter God's order, it will have serious consequences.

According to the New Testament, the head of the family (father or great father) has to ensure the spiritual and material wellbeing of the family. The Bible teaches us in 1st Timothy 5:8 that being a provider is a principle of faith. At the same time the mandate to honor the parents was not discussed. (Deuteronomy 5:16); Dishonor was cause for death (Exodus 21:15).

The children were educated in the bosom of the family, they were introduced into the worship of God and were stimulated in professional work. The family cared for their sick and elderly members (Proverbs 19:26; 20:20; 28:24).

The family was then a base where work, mutual care, service, health and Worship (family Altar) were habitual forms of life.

These principles and ordinances for today should not be violated!

Original object of the family: as God's creation, we were all made in his image and likeness (Genesis 1:26-27), so the family has the purpose of projecting on earth that image.

Image means expression. God as the Supreme Being is invisible; That man and woman named Adam and Eve, who represent humanity would be in the physical His image, His visible expression.

This tells you that through your life and example you must make your God known. In other words, man is the faithful copy of Divinity, so he becomes the visible expression of God on Earth. That was God's true purpose in creating a man and a woman, because through procreation the principle of procreation, multiplication and expansion of the family would be fulfilled.

The family is for society what is the atom for the universe; It is the cornerstone on which everything is built. The society that loses the family unit will be collapsed and destroyed.

In the purpose of God and in the revelation thought of the Kingdom, God constituted the family for:

- To be the center and communication of friendship with God. The structured family itself was the instrument through which God communicated with Man (Genesis 7:1, 7, 13) (Deuteronomy 6:6-9).
- Establish the character of God in Man.
- To exercise Dominion on Earth. (Genesis 2:15; 7:1.) for the ordering and functionality of its ministries (Genesis 4:9 49).
- For reproduction in both natural and spiritual (Genesis 28:14).

That is why your offspring must join people of the same spirit, of the same language, of the same purpose (2a Corinthians 6:14; 7:1). If we do not fulfill the assigned purpose the blessing becomes cursed, because marriage is not an end in itself, families are not entities in themselves; They are designed to fulfill the divine purpose. The family extends, does not divide.

Principles that govern Gods family:

- Order (Romans 1:20) (Luke 1:1-4).
- Government/Authority (Genesis 1:28; 9:1-3).
- Discipline, respect, fidelity, planning, restraint (1a Corinthians 14:40) (Ephesians 5).
- The power of one.
- Edification and Adoration.

The main goal of the creation of a family is to raise altar and worship God (Isaiah 43:7 and 21) (Ephesians 1:5-6 and 12).

In the Old Testament men were determined to worship, every time they're going a battle and came out of a battle, they felt the need to offer sacrifices to the Lord, because they recognized that the direction of their life and the accomplishments, depended on Their lives rendered and consecrated to the Lord.

Today the family with purpose knows that God is the owner of Everything: House, business, company, strength, economics, studies, etc., therefore yields as a family, honors the most High God and in the vision of the power of one are built to present to God a family worthy of his creation. A Christian family is not only a family made up of Christians, it is a family where Christ is Lord and where his word is the basis of his moral code.

Revival begins at home, so family altar is not a mere family reunion, but being together as a family, (Matthew 18:20) we are in alliance with God and we achieve that heaven and earth unite to manifest His kingdom on Earth. (Matthew 18:18-19) purposed families are eternally destined families, who do not die but transcend through dignified generations.

**Recommendations when exposing the topic:**

1. It is necessary that we adapt the subject according to the public to which we are exposing it because knowing its needs to know which points must be reinforced and which can be ignored.
2. Respect the time they have to give this subject; We must apply the power of synthesis.

**ACTIVITY (15 mins)**



Pact of Holiness: The Penielist will sign a contract in which he promises to stay pure sexually. If the penialist lives in free union he must promise to remain without fornication until he is married. Then play the song "I Want to fall in love more" and will read the "Pact of Holiness" with all the Penielists and then each signs and present it before God in prayer.

## 6. PENIEL: Key to Brokenness –3:30pm (30mins)

*Genesis 32:30 <sup>30</sup> So Jacob called the name of the place [a]Peniel: “For I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved.”*

Introduction: Jacob represents the believer that although he has the promise of blessing, he decides to conquer it by his own strength, giving rise to a life of double, until Jacob has a face to face encounter with the same God, and this breaks his life and begins to walk The right way.

The promise: From before birth God had made a promise to Abraham

*Gn 18:18 <sup>18</sup> since Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?*

*Genesis 26:4-5 <sup>4</sup> And I will make your descendants multiply as the stars of heaven; I will give to your descendants all these lands; and in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed; <sup>5</sup> because Abraham obeyed My voice and kept My charge, My commandments, My statutes, and My laws.”*

**GOD RESPONDS TO REBECCA : *Genesis 25:23 And the Lord said to her:“Two nations are in your womb, Two peoples shall be separated from your body; One people shall be stronger than the other, And the older shall serve the younger.”***

**THE EXAMPLE OF JACOB:** He was born taking his twin brother by the carcass. In a very clever way he tends a trap to his brother Esau knowing that his brother had to be tired. Gn. 25: 31-32 He prepared a stew and through this he was able to deceive by buying his brother's birthright. Gn. 27:24 He also shrewdly disguised himself as his brother when his father was old and blind, and he appropriate it by taking the blessing of his brother Esau by fulfilling what God had told Rebecca in Gen.25: 20-26 that the greater would serve the minor. Esau lamented because in the beginning he did not much care about his birthright

*Genesis 25:32 And Esau said, "Look, I am about to die; so what is this birthright to me?"* Jacob was, a liar, cunning, opportunist, shrewd, but even so God protected Jacob and God was with him.

Jacob goes to Padam-aram: It was so much that Jacob had done against his brother that he decided to flee because his brother was plotting to kill him when his father died. His father Isaac blessed him and told him to take a wife in Padam-aram and Jacob came out and obeyed his father.

Jacob decides to make a COVENANT WITH GOD: Gn. 28:20 (he vowed) He commits himself to be a faithful tither but what he sowed he also had to harvest. His father-in-law Laban deceived him on several occasions, he had to flee from his father-in-law's house and although he was thinking of hurting him, God told him in dreams to take care to not mistreat Jacob because he was his servant.

GOD TELLS JACOB TO RETURN TO HIS LAND: Gn. 31: 3 where his brother is there who wanted to kill him because God had made Jacob prosper so much that he became envious of his father-in-law and no longer looked at him as before.

THE BREAKING OF JACOB: While Jacob was traveling to return to the land of his father, he receives the news that his brother Esau is going to meet him, and four hundred armed men accompanied him, Jacob was very distressed because he remembered the death threats of his brother (Gen. 32: 6). This led him to intensely agonize in prayer (Gen. 32:23), God revealed to him through an angel and Jacob struggles with him all night, the angel told him in Gen. 32:26 "Let me go because the dawn is breaking," Jacob told him: "I will not let go, until you bless me" PERSEVERANCE IN PRAYER made Jacob meet face to face with God, there the liberation of his soul took place. *Genesis 33:4 <sup>4</sup> But Esau ran to meet him, and embraced him, and fell on his neck and kissed him, and they wept.*



CONCLUSION: If we give ourselves to seek God in a persevering way in prayer as Jacob did, God will reveal himself to our lives, and that encounter with him will be what will produce genuine liberation in our hearts.

APPLICATION: Let each person seek God intensely in prayer until he has a face-to-face encounter with Him.

Jacob's experience was the next day, Jacob told his brother Esau when they met, And Jacob said, *“inasmuch as I have seen your face as though I had seen the face of God, and you were pleased with me. (Genesis 33:10)*

7. THE POWER OF GENEROSITY: 4:15pm (30mins)

*Proverbs 10:4 He who has a slack hand becomes poor, But the hand of the diligent makes rich.*

*Proverbs 12:24 The hand of the diligent will rule, But the lazy man will be put to forced labor.*

*Jhon 5:17 But Jesus answered them, "My Father has been working until now, and I have been working."*

I.- The work.

The first thing that we must be clear on the subject of our finances is that giving has the power to make what is left in your hand, after having given God multiply and yield much more than you expect.

But we must ask ourselves, what is God going to multiply? How are we going to get the money to be generous and be able to prosper?

The answer is: through work.

Yes, it is, very contrary to what we have been taught to think about work, this is not a curse, but a blessing that God gave us so that we could enjoy all the fullness that he prepared for us.

The human being, but especially Latinos are used to making songs against work, but God does not think so. For God, work is a blessing that he gives us.

We must then remove from our mind the negative worldview of work and assume that work is what will put us in the superabundance of God.

Work is not only employment.



Employment is to fulfill a schedule fulfilling different functions that the same job delimits us.

Employment is only the training that God makes us to shape our character and thus have tools that we can apply the day we are the owners of our own business.

While I work, are all those actions that we carry out in our daily life to improve our quality of life, these are mostly voluntary but they generate a greater degree of well-being.

That is why when we learn to see employment as part of our work, we understand that everything that God puts us to do is only for our personal, family and community fulfillment; and this realization is obtained when our life is given to work for the greatest and best of all the leaders, our Lord Jesus Christ.

In order to see the work as the blessing that we have just described, it is necessary for us to understand that work and even employment are spiritual and that God is in the matter, because it is through our work that he gives us the power to make wealth. and manifest the overabundance promised in Malachi 3:10.

II.- The generosity.

Having already understood what God thinks about work, let's see what God himself wants us to do with our money, in terms of sowing in the kingdom.

The following are principles that the Bible teaches us to be even more economically blessed:

1.- The tithe: it is the tenth part of the earnings of your work. This was instituted by God from the beginning of the world. Genesis 14: 18-20

Abraham gave tithes to Melchizedek. Genesis 14: 17-20.

The tithe is something dedicated to Jehovah. 2 Chronicles 31: 5.

Tithe is given for obedience to the word. The tithes will become a test of obedience to God, of all that He gives you, you will set aside the tithe for the Lord, in love and obedience to his commandment.

Tithes open the heavens in favor of your house and blessing is poured out until it overflows (Malachi 3:10).

Tithes make the devourer and the financial destroyer flee, tithing is a weapon of war against scarcity and poverty. (Malachi 3:11)

Tithing makes your house a fertile and desirable land that means that the seed, (the money) will seek you because you are a good land, the tithes will make other families call yours, blessed. (Malachi 3:12)

2.- The offering: it is an action of gratitude of the heart of man for God, the action of generosity of the heart blesses the offering.

The first giver was God himself. He gave us His Son so that we would be saved, healthy and freed from sin; and in this way it opened the way to giving, letting go of what we like the most: money.

I will bring an offering of gratitude to your altar, and I will pray in your name. In the courtyards of your temple, in the center of Jerusalem, and in the presence of all your people, I will fulfill my promises. Praise our God! Psalm 116: 17-19

When you give to God, He returns to you multiplied, in time of crisis, giving to God will make us prosper and that nothing will be lacking.

May God answer you when you find yourself in trouble; May the God of Israel give you his protection. May God send you his help from his sanctuary; May God give you his support from Jerusalem. May God always remember all your offerings, and welcome with pleasure the animals that you present in his honor. Psalm 20: 1-3

3.- The seeds: To produce a harvest there must be a sowing, when you want to provoke a harvest, when you want God to grant a request, you must give a seed, Ana gave as seed to her son Samuel and reaped a prophet and five children more.

If you sow in abundance, you will gather a harvest in abundance (2 Corinthians 9: 6-11), if you sow sparingly so will your harvest be.

The power that the seed unleashes in your family:

- Abundance and you will have enough. (vs8)
- God will always provide you with seed and bread. (vs10)
- The seed unleashes multiplication of seeds and unleashes the power of increase in our finances. (vs10)
- The power of the seed unties riches to continue sowing and investing in the kingdom. (vs11)
- The law of sowing and reaping was what God established man for his sustenance in the beginning (Genesis 1:29).

4.- The first fruits: It is an act of wisdom and intelligence of man, dedication to God and covenant; because with this action it is confirmed that He gave us the ability to make wealth. Deuteronomy 8:18.

The law of the first fruits reveals to us that God must be the first in our lives. When God is loved as first in our house everything will be granted (Matthew 6:33).

That is why we must separate the first thing we receive in the year as a first-time offering, you must offer the first two weeks or first salary of your work, the first fruit of your harvest, the first profit of your business, and that will bring protection and redemption to all your house and all your finances.

The offering of firstfruits of the first month brings protection throughout your house (Exodus 12: 2, 12-13) no plague, disease may touch your house by the power of the offering of firstfruits.

When we honor God with our first fruits, the following blessings will be manifested:

- Your barns will be filled with plenty. The first fruits activate the power of abundance in your home and family.
- Your bank accounts, your wallet, your refrigerator will be full, your house will be filled with everything well with abundance, poverty will never touch your family.
- "Your wine presses will overflow with must", the firsts activate the power of the overflow, the scarce is transformed into overflow, you will never be short on finances, short on budget, everything will be left over because of the power of the overflow.
- There are terrible consequences for families who know this principle and do not live it. Example, Achan's familiar curse (Joshua 7: 21-25).

### **ACTIVITY (15 mins)**



Offering and Tithes: In all Peniels, participants should be given the opportunity to honor God with their offerings and begin to be committed to their tithes. After the preaching "The Power of Generosity" The preacher will take the time to raise the offering and then make an act of commitment to God to be responsible with our Tithes, they will receive envelopes of Tithes to present them symbolically to God and make the " Prayer of commitment ", those who do not have to tithe at that time will carry their envelopes with them to deliver their tithes whenever possible.

"The offering must be counted by the Administrator together with the Peniel coordinator, and between them they must complete the respective report and sign it.

### **PRAYER OF COMMITMENT**

Jehovah God, just as you have commanded today I present this envelope of Tithe before you promising that forever I will be faithful with my Tithes and Offerings. Fulfill your promises about my family, that according to Malachi 3 you will rebuke the devourer and open the windows of heaven to bless us until theres an overflow, my descendants will never beg bread, and in your house your abundance will flow, amen.

## 8. Vision H2o **5:00pm** (45min)

In our H2o church we have a passion; to reach people away from Jesus and see them become disciples of Him.

But how to do it? If you were one of the twelve disciples of Jesus how would you do it? The way Jesus did, of course. that is why in our church we have been concerned with studying the development of Jesus' ministry through the Gospels. The Lord made more disciples than others because he applied the most appropriate model. Now we can replicate His model to disciple and care for those He has entrusted to us.

### **How did Jesus do it?**

#### 1. He had compassion for the crowds. **(Won)**

- Jesus had compassion for the multitudes who followed him (Matthew 9: 35-37)
- Jesus never thought about a few, always many, so he trained twelve to take care of the crowds.
- In order to have compassion for the multitudes we need to understand that every person has a soul that has to be won, from the one who lives under the bridge to the one who built the bridge. Everyone must gain eternal life.
- Jesus did it preaching in the fields and making groups in the houses, we call these groups in our church H2Groups.

#### 2. He manifested His Power. **(Consolidated)**

- Jesus filled the needs of people by manifesting his healer and liberator.
- The purpose of power is for people to be liberated, affirmed, and believe in the Lord. (Mr 1.27-45, Mr 2 1-12, Jn 2.23, Jn 6.2)



In our church we consolidate those who have been won through 3 steps:

**1. The BTT:** We gave you the manual "I Was Born to TRIUMPH" and visited their homes the same week they were won.

**2. The location of the Group:** In order for the person to be able to care effectively, immediately after the conversion he / she must be assigned to a group where he / she can share with other believers.

**3. The DBH:** We teach them Deliverance, Blessing, and Healing, through three different classes.

**4. THE Peniel:** Will minister to you profoundly in our spiritual retreat where the power of God is manifested through signs, healing, deliverance, and baptism in the Holy Spirit.

**5. Baptism in Water.** During one of the services in our church we baptized you in water celebrating your transformation as Jesus commanded.

3. He chose twelve people. (Disciple)

- He called those he wanted. He chose his disciples, his disciples did not choose him. (Mt 9:35 to 10: 4)
- He chose with purpose, for the objective to achieve (take care of the multitudes).
- Established a certain number of workers: 12.
- Discipling is not indoctrinating, it is forming people. He called them to be made "fishers of men."





- Jesus disciplined whoever he wanted to work with, not just the one who wanted to hear or learn. To be a disciple is to be a worker of the Lord and a collaborator in the vision of God.
- In H2o we disciplined as he Jesus did, through a training system called "**Agents of Peace**". This is given by a leader once a week from the houses to the people who are being disciplined. This process lasts three months (12 classes of 45 minutes).

#### 4. He sent them to do the same. (Sent)

- After discipleship he gave them authority over all the enemy's strength and sent them two by two to do the same (win, consolidate, disciple, and send others). (Luke 10:19)
- They were so effective that they returned with 72 trained disciples (12 disciples for every 6 couples that Jesus sent) to whom Jesus sent in the same way. (Luke 10.1-2)
- In H2o we use a special graduation called "**Launch**" in which we empower the disciples to be sent and do in the lives of others what God did in them through their leaders.

Jesus said that the harvest is great, and that the workers are few. He said that we should ask the Lord to send more workers. The harvest will always bring more harvests, which will require more workers. What God seeks and establishes are people willing to work in the work of the Kingdom (The Harvest). Every worker with the right vision will raise the harvest, conscious that we have to win, consolidate, disciple and send more workers. Whenever the harvest is collected, more workers must be made, who will bring more harvest.

**You are the worker that God will use to transform this city one disciple at a time.**

## WHY TWO?

Jesus sent them two by two because he knew the Biblical principle that says: "Two are better than one ..." (Ec 4.9). This consists of two people working as a team to raise the harvest, take care of it and send new workers. Both the twelve and the seventy sent them two in two. Here are some of the couples that God formed to serve him in the work:

- Adam and Eve, to start the human race
- Moses and Aaron, for the Exodus from Egypt
- Joshua and Caleb, for the conquest of Canaan
- Elijah and Elisha, who prophesied against idolatry
- Elisha and Gehazi, who continued the work of Elijah
- David and Jonathan, before the most prosperous reign of Israel
- Peter and John, in the early Church
- Paul on his missionary trips with Bernabé, Silas or Timothy
- Jesus and the Holy Spirit
- The two witnesses in Revelation
- Even the devil will send a couple: The Antichrist and the false prophet.

## WHY TWO?

The number twelve in the Bible indicates organization, perfection of government, supervision. Also service, power and protection. Here are some examples of using the number twelve in the Bible

- Twelve were the sons of Jacob, the patriarchs (Gen 35.22)
- Twelve are the tribes of Israel (Gn 49.28)
- Even Ishmael had 12 princes (Gn 17.20)
- Twelve were the sources of Elim (Ex 15.27)
- Moses sent twelve spies to the Promised Land (Deut 1.20-22)
- Twelve chosen by Joshua to raise the altar with the stones of the Jordan
- Twelve were the judges of Israel (Jue)
- Solomon established twelve officers to govern Israel (1 King 4.7)
- Jesus chose twelve apostles to start his Church (Mt 10.1-4)
- Twelve are the thrones on which the apostles will sit judging the twelve tribes of Israel. (Lk 22.30)
- Twelve legions of angels that Jesus could ask for his protection (Mt 26.53)
- Around the throne of God there are twenty-four thrones where twenty-four elders sit (12x2) (Rev. 4.4).

- 144,000 saints in the final time, sealed Jews; twelve thousand from each tribe of Israel (12x12,000) (Ap 7.4)
- Jerusalem, the city of God, has twelve gates, with twelve angels at the gates. The wall of the city has twelve foundations and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. It has twelve stones and twelve foundations. It measures 12,000 stadiums (Ap 21.9-21)
- In the upper room there were 120 praying. On the day of Pentecost they became 3,000 (both multiples of twelve).

The model of the twelve has been the one that God has always adopted to reign over his people. When he formed the nation of Israel he did it through twelve tribes, he judged it through twelve judges and governed it through the twelve officers.

Jesus also used this model. The Church was established by twelve disciples of his called "apostles", whom he trained and sent. Before dying he gave accounts to the Father only of these. Pastors, like Jesus, should be accountable to God only of twelve disciples of his Church.

After the ascension of Christ, the Holy Spirit led the eleven apostles to choose another one of the disciples to take the place of Judas. They themselves had understood the importance of the model of the twelve and filled the vacancy before starting the evangelistic work. Today, the Spirit of God is moving us back to the same sense of God, in order to raise a great harvest of the last times, and take care of each believer for the glorious day of the return of the Beloved.

Now is your time to be trained, this Peniel is the graduation of your consolidation, now you will immediately begin your disguise through the school of life. Once a week you will receive twelve classes that will empower you to become a true disciple of Jesus Christ. In this class we will help you strengthen your family, better manage your time and



finances, and love God with all your strength. Next week you will need to start your school of life together with your group leader to be graduated and launched very soon and manifest all that God has for you.

Go ahead, the best is yet to come.

### **ACTIVITY (15mins)**

**Pact of Fidelity Sheet**: It is a contract in which the Penielist will sign promising to be faithful to God and to the vision of the church to work in groups and start their school of life. The commitment sheet will be passed to each Penielist, it will be read out loud with the group, they will sign it, and they will present it before God in prayer. Then you will minister to each Penielist praying to God to give them a strong spirit of commitment to the Vision while playing the song (your promises).

9. (Men) New Men. **8:41pm** (20 mins)

**(Before the preaching the Video from Rob Bell “ Amarte Menos”, will play.)**

Because of Adam's sin spiritual and physical death came into humanity, and also the sinful nature entered, this man who walks in the sinful nature that is rebellious and disobedient to God is the old man, when we receive Jesus in our hearts the nature of God enters us, the Holy Spirit enters, and our spirit is recreated and resurrected.

This teaches us that there are two natures in us; the sinful and the divine; Romans 8: 12-13 teaches us that through the power of the Spirit we can put the sinful nature to death in our lives and walk in the divine nature.

I. - Characteristics of the old man (Ephesians 4: 17-22)

- They walk in the vanity of their mind (they have vain thoughts). (v. 17)
- They have darkened understanding (they are ignorant of the things of God). (v.18)
- They have a hardened heart (they are insensitive to the things of God) (v.18).
- Hardness of heart brings disobedience and rebellion.
- By the loss of sensitivity to God they became immoral (v 19).
- The old man manifests the works of the flesh (Galatians 5: 19-21).

II.- Stripping us of the old man (Ephesians 4: 20-24)

By hearing and being taught in the truth of Christ we are stripped of the old man (v 21).

If you feed yourself with the word of God, music with messages of faith and of kingdom, you read the Bible, you listen to apostolic messages, you congregate, you have a life of constant prayer; your spiritual man is

strengthened and your old man weakens and dies. It is like a man who has two dogs, if this man feeds more one of the two, and puts them to fight, the dog that is better fed will win, that's the way in the spiritual life, if you feed your spirit more and do not feed the flesh, you will live a life in the Spirit.

To get rid of the old man has to do with an act of the will through the power of the Spirit, God does not deprive you, you get rid of the old man.

The word STRIP OF comes from the Greek word "Apotithem" which means: draw from one, leave, discard the old thoughts and attitudes.

III.- Dressing in the new man (Ephesians 4: 23-24 NKJV).

To be clothed with the new man there must be a change of mind and attitude (v.23)

The word "renewed" means placing new thoughts repeatedly in our mind, these thoughts are acquired with the teaching and practice of the word of God (vs 23)

When the Bible speaks of renewing the spirit of our mind it speaks of changing from a critical and negative attitude to an attitude of faith.

Romans 12: 2 teaches renewal more accurately: Do not be conformed to this world: this means, do not have the way of thinking about this anti-God system, do not have the scheme of thought of the world, do not have the way of thinking of the majority of people.

Transform yourself through the renewal of your understanding: This means that for there to be a change in our life, we must change our way of thinking through the principles of God that are established in his word.



When you do not have the scheme of thought of the world and change your way of thinking, you will prove the will of God, which is good, pleasant and perfect.

The word "put on" means to put on one, invest, put on, redress. You have to dress of justice, holiness and truth of God that are essential characteristics in your new nature. (v. 24)

Stripping and dressing can be compared, taking away the Adamic nature and dressing with the nature of Christ.

Positionally and legally on the cross our old man was crucified buried (Romans 6: 4-6) and when Christ was resurrected, we were resurrected to a new life.

Ephesians 4: 22-24 speaks of the possession of the new man in our life, which is to take what Jesus legally conquered on the cross for us, is to move from the legal to the experiential.

IV.- Fruits of walking in the new man (Ephesians 4: 25-32)

The new man rejects the lie and speaks truth (v. 25)

The new man understands that there is no individualism because we are a body (v. 25) "because we are members of one another".

Do not let anger make you say and do things that hurt other people, because anger blinds you, do not stay angry because that's where you give place to the devil (verses 26-27).

Do not be dishonest, be productive and generous (vs 28).



Take away from you the words of cursing and disbelief, take away from you words that destroy and offend others and use your mouth to bless and edify and teach others (vs 29).

Do not quench or offend the Holy Spirit with bad attitudes and cursing words (vs 30)

The new man has the power to remove the bitterness, anger, screaming and malice. The new man is kind, merciful and forgiving (vs 32)

### **ACTIVITY (30 mins)**

**New Man Act:** After the preaching a blank page will be given to each Man and they will be asked how the devil called them before (Adulter, liar, etc.) Then they will be put on their knees and one by one they will be asked to break the paper and they will be anointed touching their right shoulder with a sword asking them to stand up and declaring a new name (Free, powerful, good father, etc.), while playing the song ( Men of Valor.) (spanish song: Hombre de Valor)

9. (Woman). ESTHER 8:41pm (20 mins)

**(BEFORE THE PREACHING PLAY THE Video “Un Largo Viaje”)**

*ESTHER 5:1-2*

*1. Now it happened on the third day that Esther put on her royal robes and stood in the inner court of the king's palace, across from the king's house, while the king sat on his royal throne in the royal house, facing the entrance of the [a]house. <sup>2</sup> So it was, when the king saw Queen Esther standing in the court, that she found favor in his sight, and the king held out to Esther the golden scepter that was in his hand. Then Esther went near and touched the top of the scepter.*

**Who was Haman?**

He was a man who rose up against the Jews and wanted to exterminate them. He was an arrogant man, who wanted to fulfill his purpose no matter what. Our initial response to the story of Haman is to say that he got what he deserved. But the Bible leads us to ask deeper questions: "How much of Haman is in me?", "Do I want to control others?", "Do I feel threatened when others do not appreciate me as I think they should?" "Am I looking for revenge when my pride is attacked?" Confess these attitudes to God and ask him to replace them with an attitude of forgiveness. Otherwise, the justice of God will be responsible for solving the problem.

Strengths and achievements:

- He achieved great power, he was second in command after Ahasuerus, king of Persia.

Weaknesses and errors:

- The desire to control others and receive honor was his greatest goal.

- He was blinded by his arrogance and presumption
- He planned the murder of Mordecai and built a gallows for him
- Orchestrated the plan to massacre the people of God of the entire empire.

We are going to see three women in the book of Esther, and compare how much we have of them in our lives:

### **Who was Zeres?**

Zeres was Haman's wife, who influenced him to make the decision to kill the Jewish people.

#### *Esther 5:9-14*

*<sup>9</sup> So Haman went out that day joyful and with a glad heart; but when Haman saw Mordecai in the king's gate, and that he did not stand or tremble before him, he was filled with indignation against Mordecai. <sup>10</sup> Nevertheless Haman restrained himself and went home, and he sent and called for his friends and his wife Zeresh. <sup>11</sup> Then Haman told them of his great riches, the multitude of his children, everything in which the king had promoted him, and how he had advanced him above the officials and servants of the king. <sup>12</sup> Moreover Haman said, "Besides, Queen Esther invited no one but me to come in with the king to the banquet that she prepared; and tomorrow I am again invited by her, along with the king. <sup>13</sup> Yet all this avails me nothing, so long as I see Mordecai the Jew sitting at the king's gate."<sup>14</sup> Then his wife Zeresh and all his friends said to him, "Let a gallows<sup>[a]</sup> be made, <sup>[b]</sup>fifty cubits high, and in the morning suggest to the king that Mordecai be hanged on it; then go merrily with the king to the banquet." And the thing pleased Haman; so he had the gallows made.*

### **How much of Zeres is there in us?**

In what way are you influencing your family that will lead to destruction? Trying to take advantage of a situation your way, but what you're doing is killing a generation.

### **Who Was Queen Vasti?**

- She was Rebel - she did not hear the voice of her beloved - King Ahasuerus
- A woman who contaminates others- (When the King sent her to come to show her off in the moment of the feast to his guest, she did not want to go ... etc.)
- When she did not show up, her guests said that the other women would say she did not want to pay attention to her King, now the other women will take that as an example to do the same.
- A arrogant woman, when the king commanded her to come, she preferred not to go and make her own banquet ..

How many times does the king call us and we do not go ... Do not contaminate other people with your attitudes.

### **Who was Queen Esther?**

Her past:

She did not grow up with her parents. She had no mother, father, brothers, ... We see that at the moment she is an orphan, she went to live with her uncle Mordecai. Where she could not have that warmth of a mother. etc.

- She grew up with inferiority-
- Sadness in her heart-
- Grew up with low-esteem-

### **Lets see her present:**

When she went to the palace a process of 12 months passed. 6 months with oil of myrrh and 6 months with aromatic perfume and shaves and better care. Not knowing what was going to happen to her ... (Process we all went through processes) .. !! There are things in our lives that God has to take away and make us new, it's like a saying beauty hurts.

- She did not believe that she was going to do something that would change the course of her life and that of her people.
- She let herself go through the processes
- She was humble, she did not show rebellion for having taken her out of her house to marry a man she did not know.

### **The Future of Queen Esther**

- A Queen - With God's principles
- Who knew the authority she had - Woman is time to know your authority in God!
- She was not scared- (She said if I perish than I'll perish). But I will not remain silent letting the enemy destroy mines ...
- A Queen of decrees-
- With Wisdom- (she knows when she must speak, she must act, she must make decisions) she did not go against Haman but prepared a banquet for her enemy ..
- Woman of Prayer and Fasting,

Then Esther had determination ("if I perish, than I'll perish"). All revelation of the Word will bear fruit when I am determine before the Word of revelation placed on me, as long as I do not make decisions in response to the voice of God I will continue with an internal struggle in a conflict that will never end that I am giving legal right to the darkness over my life.

*Esther 4:12-14*

*12 So they told Mordecai Esther's words. 13 And Mordecai told them to answer Esther: "Do not think in your heart that you will escape in the king's palace any more than all the other Jews. 14 For if you remain completely silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father's house will perish. Yet who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this?"*

Woman listening to advice. (Of his uncle Mardoqueo) That represents the Holy Spirit.

She appears before the King with the best, and the King had favor and granted him what he asked. That he had in the banquet that she had prepared for his King and Amám.

Esther was locked up three days and three nights, she did not leave the court, she decided to die (Esther 4:15)

It is necessary to make firm decisions to send Aman to the gallows. Said Jesus: *Matthew 16:24-25*<sup>24</sup> *Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. 25 For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it.*

In Esther 5:1-2 she decides to die for herself but to live for God and that determination produces the necessary changes to send to the gallows Aman, so that no longer enseñoree of it.

All of Aman Falls and Mordecai occupies the first place, they put the royal ring and this produces fruits to the whole nation. In the Book of Esther shows us through this summary as we can see the work regenerative and sanctifying the Holy Spirit to a person.



So Be:

- Obedient women
- Self Dominion
- Demonstrating the fruits of the spirit: which are: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, meekness, and Self Control. To bring our family to the freedom that God wants to give! Amen.

The king did not care from where Queen Esther was.. And protected her and command to kill her enemy Haman... We must be brave women to confront the enemy and be more wise.

Woman: God I created you according to his image and likeness, a woman of value with a maternal heart your a wife you are the work of his hands, created in Christ Jesus to make a warrior of God, this the time for each woman to begin to see how she is an instrument of peace to More and tenacity... Woman This is the time rise up with the fullness of the Holy Spirit, for today you have found favor before the king. Women ready to govern?

Message to the Apostles, Pastors... Women who have given their time to God Family Ministry, have given everything, and had people who have betrayed you, but also as you have kept under the rule of the Holy Spirit today God will bring refreshment to your heart and will enter a new level of government About their lives where the requests of their hearts will be answered, because you have found grace with the king This is the time for that you are in the position that this. To bring God's people to a new dimension of worship, intercession seeking God. To bring the women of their congregations to a dimension of dominion and lordship. In the name of Jesus I declare a new level of authority now over their lives!

**ACTIVITY (30 mins)**

**Coronation:** A throne must be prepared beforehand with a wreath and flowers in which it is represented that King Jesus is seated. After the preaching they will go to the Penielist line and one by one they kneel before the throne to anoint them and crown them as queens, Brides of Jesus, while the video is played a long Has sido largo el Viaje. It is very important to remind the penalists that these are only prophetic acts, representations.

## 10. BAPTISM 7:45am (30mins)

Jesus ordained to all those who believed in Him, to be baptized in water.

*18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go [a]therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Mathew 28:18-19, Acts 2: 38-41*

Being "baptized" means being "totally submerged." When a person repents of his sin and believes that Jesus died for him, that person must be baptized before many witnesses by means of immersing himself completely into the waters.

### A. Understanding baptism in water

Understanding the meaning of baptism in water is the key to a liberated and victorious Christian life.

The act of submerging under the waters and re-surfacing is a picture that shows what has happened in the life of the Christian believer.

### B. Four stages of the work of Christ represented

#### 1. He died... I died in Him

*6 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be [a]done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. 7 For he who has died has been [b]freed from sin. (Romans 6:6-7)*

#### 2. He was buried... I was buried together with him

*3 Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? 4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from*

*the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. (Romans 6:3-4)*

3. He was resurrected... I have a new life in Him

*<sup>4</sup> Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.<sup>5</sup> For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, (Roman 6:4-5)*

4. He ascended... I ascended in Him

*<sup>6</sup> and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, (Ephesians 2:6) Read as well (Colossians 3:1)*

C. Baptism in water is...

1. To die to sin and the world!

So, because you have "died" in Christ, you proceed to bury your ancient life in the baptism in water.

2. Your resurrection in the New Life

You rise from the baptismal waters demonstrating and declaring that you are a new creation in Christ.

*<sup>8</sup> Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him,*

*<sup>9</sup> knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more.*

*Death no longer has dominion over Him. <sup>10</sup> For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.*

*<sup>11</sup> Likewise you also, <sup>[a]</sup>reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6: 8-11).*

D. The Two Kingdom

***13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and <sup>[a]</sup>conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, (Colossians 1:13).***

Every man or woman who was born in the world, was born in the Kingdom of Darkness; Born as a slave to the dictator Satan. There is no way to escape from such a kingdom except by way of death, and there is no way to the Kingdom of God except through BIRTH. So, Jesus came to be both our death and our new birth, which we declare through baptism in water.

#### E. The two Races

Just as there are two kingdom, likewise, within each realm there is a different race of people. The Adamic Race dwells in the Kingdom of darkness and the new creation dwells in the Kingdom of God.

##### 1. The first Adam

***22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. ( 1 Corinthians 15:22) Read to Romans 5:12.***

Adam was the father of all of us, of the whole human race. Adam's sin has pushed us all from God. Because of his sin, we all inherit the rebellions and sick nature, coming to be subject to death. The offspring of Adam was called the "Adamic Race."

##### 2. The New Adam

"For Christ, when we were still weak, in his time he died for the wicked" (Romans 5:6). There was No way that God could change the fallen Adamic race. I had to put an end to that fallen race and start a whole new one. Jesus was the last Adam. He came as the last born of the Adamic race and the firstborn of a new race.

When hung on the cross, he was hung as the ultimate Adam: The last born of the Adamic race. When he died on the cross, the Adamic race and the sinful Adamic Nature died.

God killed in him the fall creation. The Adamic Race died in Christ.

### 3. The Second Men

*22 ...For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. ( 1. Corinthians 15:22)* Jesus came as the new Man of God, through whom, a new race would be created. Jesus rose from the dead, not as the last Adam, but rather as the second man, the head of the new creation.

*45 And so it is written, “The first man Adam became a living being.” The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.*

*46 However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, and afterward the spiritual. 47 The first man was of the earth, made<sup>[a]</sup> of dust; the second Man is <sup>[b]</sup>the Lord from heaven. 48 As was the <sup>[c]</sup>man of dust, so also are those who are made of dust; and as is the heavenly Man, so also are those who are heavenly. 49 And as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we<sup>[d]</sup> shall also bear the image of the heavenly Man. ( 1 Corinthians 15:45-49).*

### 4. The New Creation

*17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. (2. Corinthians 5:17).*  
Read Ephesians 2:10.

In baptism in water we declare publicly, to all our friends and acquaintances, that we are no longer part of the race of Adam nor of the Kingdom of Darkness. We are a new creation in Christ and belong to the Kingdom of God.

### FREQUENT QUESTIONS:



1. How long do I have to be a Christian to be baptized? The first moment you believed in Jesus as Savior you are ready to be baptized. Many biblical examples demonstrate this, one of whom is the eunuch evangelized by Philip, the very day he became baptized. Acts 8:26-40

2. What happens when I get baptized? You full fill the mandate that Jesus gave to believe and be baptized. Mathew 28:19

3. What if I was baptized in the past and I want to be baptized again? In the Bible there is no limitation as often as you want to baptize, baptism is the affirmation that you have decided to die to the world to live for Christ, if you have decided that once again nothing prevents you from getting baptized again.

### YOUR DECISION

If you have believed in Jesus Christ as your savior there is nothing to prevent you from baptizing, if you have things to change do not fear, Jesus will be with you to help you, today is your day.

### ACTIVITY (15MIN)

**REGISTRY FOR THE BAPTISM DATES:** After the conference, the song "Your Promises" will be put and the Penielist will be lined up to sign their names on a blank paper as a sign accepting the challenge and commitment to be baptized. These signatures will be used to prepare your baptism dates which will be delivered at the farewell with there paperwork.

**11. Knowing the person of the Holy Spirit 8:30am (15mins)**

***John 14:15-17***

*15 "If you love Me, [a]keep My commandments. 16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another [b]Helper, that He may abide with you forever — 17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.*

Your whole life to be successful depends on how sensitive you are to the Holy Spirit.

Because three are the ones who testify in the sky: the father, the Son and the Holy Spirit; And these three are one. 1 John. 5:7.

**I.-Defining important things**

1.-He's not a thing, he's a person.

All attributes of a person He has (John 16:13)

a. Speaks.

One day, while they were worshipping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said to them: "Prepare me to Barnabas and Saul. I have chosen them for a special mission. " Acts 13:2

B. Feels.

Do not make the Holy Spirit of God sad, which is like a seal of identity that God put in you, to recognize you when the day comes when you will forever be liberated from sin. Ephesians 4:30

C. Prohibits

Paul and his companions tried to announce the message of God in the province of Asia, but the Holy Spirit did not allow it. Then they traveled through the region of Frigo and Galatia. Acts 16:6

D.-Mentor

When the Holy Spirit comes, he will tell you what the truth is and guide you, so that you will always live in the truth. He will not speak on his own account, but tell them what he hears from God the Father, and he will teach them what is to happen. John 16:13

He is a person, not just a presence, as a person has a presence, an atmosphere emanating from him.

It's like a person you know (there are people who change the atmosphere of a place).

His presence is the evidence of his person.

2.-He is the comforter sent as a former for us. John 14:16,17 and 26.

Comforter: Parakletos, means expert in laws, that is what Paul expressed in Rom 8:26 in the same way, and since our trust in God is weak, the Holy Spirit helps us. Because we do not know how to pray to God, but the Spirit himself prays for us, and does so so special that there are no words to express it.

and 1st Corinthians 2:10,12.

God gave us to know all this through his spirit, because the spirit of God examines everything, even the deepest secrets of God. No one can know what another person thinks. Only the spirit of that person knows what she is thinking. In the same way, only the spirit of God knows what God thinks. But as God gave us his spirit, we can realize what God, in his goodness, has done for us.

He is a comforter: mentor, teacher, someone who deciphers the codes to make you a winner.

3.-He is a person not heavy, but refreshing, cheerful, wise.

The Holy Spirit refreshes you, rejoices you, imparts you.

4.-He is a person who puts you in the right direction and speed. Acts 2:2

All of a sudden. Blows

II.-He comes as an answer to the prayers of Jesus.

1.-He comes so that we do not remain orphaned. JUAN14:16-18. We're not orphans, we have heaven inside us.

2.-He comes so you are not caught by the deception. John 14:17. John 16:13 The Truth gives you security in the midst of deceit. Truth is not a feeling is a person. John 14:6, Colossians 2:2-3.

3.-He comes because we are in Christ an excellent product. The Spirit of God made me, and the breath of the Almighty gave me life. Job 33:4. He does not come to beings that are not compatible with his nature. John 14:17 The sinner only brings conviction. Only the Christian penetrates to make his room.

Or know ye not that your body is the Temple of the Holy Spirit, which is in you, which you have of God, and which are not yours? 1 Corinthians 6:19 Nothing bad can happen to you if He's there. Remember:

**HE IS NOT ONE THING, HE IS A PERSON**

## **12. The fullness of the Holy Spirit 8:45 am (30 mins)**

But when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, you will receive power and testify to me in Jerusalem, in every region of Judea and Samaria, and even in the farthest parts of the earth. Acts 1:8 (D.H.H.)

You will receive power: in Greek it is *dunamis*, which means strength, miraculous power, a miracle in itself, efficacy. Force, impetuous, wonder, capacity, give, powerfully, power, powers.

When we receive the Holy Spirit we are receiving, strength, power, efficacy, authority, etc. Example: Peter, a coward who had failed his master we found him preaching to multitudes. Acts 2:14-39.

And you will be witnesses to me: the Holy Spirit is not given to us only for our pleasure, it comes to train ourselves in order to transform the city, the nation and the world with the message of the Gospel (Vision-Mission H2O).

In the version "God Speaks Today" says: You will receive power and come out to testify. The Holy Spirit in US cannot be left alone as a manifestation of Sensations but it must drive us to achieve the purpose that each one has.

I.-How did the Holy Spirit manifest Himself in the Book of acts?

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all unanimous together. And suddenly a roar came from the sky like a strong wind blowing, which filled the whole house where they were seated; And they appeared to them tongues spread, as of fire, settling on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak in other tongues, according to the Spirit gave them to speak. They dwelt then in Jerusalem Jews, Godly men, of all the nations under the sky. And made this roar,

the multitude gathered; And they were confused, because each one heard them speak in their own language. And they were astonished and marveled, saying, behold, are not all these Galileans who speak?

How, then, do we hear them speak each one in our language in which we were born? Cretans and Arabs, we hear them speak in our tongues the wonders of God. And they were all astonished and perplexed, saying to each other: what does this mean? But others, mocking, said: They are full of must. Acts 2:1-13 (RVR60)

A. When the day came. There is a designated day for all, being here on this date, on this day is because we are on the appointed day.

When it came time to show them my kindness, I was kind to you; When they needed salvation, I gave them freedom. "Listen up! That opportune moment has come. Today is the day God can save you! 2a Corinthians 6:2

B. Came from the sky a lightning. It is something that you have never felt before and had in you, because it comes from heaven, promised by God (John. 16), that it would be upon us, for us and in us. A lightning, because all your body is overturned by the touch of God, as the Spirit is power (Dunamis) is like receiving an electric shock, it produces shivering, falls, laughter, chills, because your body is perceiving and receiving something external in you.

C. Like a tough wind blowing. When a strong wind strikes a place you know that everything in its path moves and knocks it down, this is how the Holy Spirit comes into our lives to remove everything that we had accumulated for years and that God needs to bring down in our lives to plant others in that place. Juan. 16:8.

And when he comes, he will convince the world of sin, justice and judgment.

He will convince: it is a task of destroying thoughts that have become fortresses against the truth, so its task is of a strong wind that blows.

D. Which filled the whole house where they were. The spirit comes to produce a total full... my cup is battering. The word compares to a life with a house and says: When a house is clean tidy but empty, wickedness returns with seven worse spirits. This is done to fill it because of being empty, so the Holy Spirit produces a fullness to leave no room for doubt or the force of evil that seeks to operate from our lives.

E. And they appeared tongues spread like fire. There will be external manifestations of what God is doing inside. It's like being in love, you have a feeling inside but there are external manifestations of that on the outside.

F. They are full of must (wine). We all know the characteristic of a drunk person: he laughs, sings, speaks aloud, has no fear of ridicule.

This is when we are filled with the spirit, we break with those things that limit us: we preach without fear, we speak loud, no matter what others mocked by what we are saying.

II.-How were they filled and spoke other tongues?

A. They were all together. When the day of Pentecost came, they were all unanimous together.

Together: It has to do with what were gathered there, they were waiting for the fulfillment of the promise, something happens when we are together, here in this meeting we are together because we came with a single feeling, ready to have an encounter with God.

B. All of a sudden. How are you going to get the tongues? All of a sudden. When are you going to be full? All of a sudden.

C. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit and His outpouring is not for some it is for all and that is the guarantee, that all of us here are going to be filled with the Holy Spirit.

D. They all spoke in new languages. In the world there are more than seven thousand languages and many dialects, besides there are angelic languages, so do not just speak a language, open for God and let the new creature you are now express your new language!

How do children start speaking their language? Imitating his father, babbling. The word says, open your mouth that I will fill it. Let the spirit use your body and you can express yourself through your mouth.

III.-What role does your mind play in the outpouring of the Spirit? (Acts 2:6-13)

A.-and made this lighting the multitude gathered; And they were confused. Your thoughts will be your greatest enemy to speak in other tongues because they will ask you many questions (the crowd is gathered), if you listen to them they will bring confusion to your life. To speak in new tongues The first thing you will have to do is, not to listen to your mind, because many questions and questioning will come that if you listen to them they'll leave you confused, Ephesians 4:23... "And renew yourselves in the spirit of your mind." The mind is being put in the background, she knows she is not in control of that situation and will want to persuade you not to speak in other tongues.

Thoughts like these will come to your mind: you're crazy! You're looking ridiculous! What your friends are going to think now, your parents! You, a educated person believing these things!

B. They were stunned and marveled. You will pass through your thoughts a mixture of emotions, because you'll feel strange but at the same time with an indescribable joy.

### C. The wonders of God.

Speaking in tongues is talking mysteries. The word mystery means revelation, when one speaks in tongue we are speaking in a language of heaven, we are communicated with God, and although our mind does not understand our spirit is being taught and built by God himself through the Holy Spirit.

"He who speaks in a strange tongue, himself is built"; 1a Corinthians 14:3a. For if I pray in unknown tongue, my spirit is praying, but my understanding is without fruit (understand). 1Corinthians 14:14.

### **Guide to ministering the fullness of the Holy Spirit (45 mins)**

Next we will give a series of instructions that serve as guide to the moment of the ministration.

- Each group will be joined with their help and guide in charge of the Ministration for each group to guide them in speaking in tongues.
- You will explain the process of receiving the tongues.
- The group guide will begin speaking in tongues and so others will follow as they are taught to speak and then they will be on there own speaking in tongues.
- Once the person is identified, the guide of the group will raise a hand to nod that the tongues are being received.
- You will have two people coordinating this moment which by means of audio will motivate speaking in tongues, praying from the microphones in tongues.

- than finally they will be taken into account of all those who received the speaking in tongues.

Before the end of the Peniel, the activity must be carried out with the letters of the relatives, which is explained below:

The days before the Peniel the Administrator with the staffs should contact the relatives of the Peniel, (preferably the people who live with him or her) and ask them to write a letter to their relative who goes to the Peniel, highlighting the good things about him or Her, in which she expresses all the love she has for the person.

During the Peniel, each server must also write a letter to each person in charge.

After ministering all the topics they will be given in an envelope all the cards that each penielist have and you will asked not to open the envelope until the distributions of all the letters are given.

Once the last envelope is delivered, the Penielist will be asked to read each one of their letters. It is a very emotional moment in which the servers must be attentive to give a hug to those who need it. You also need to have facial towels to give to those who need them.

At this time the package is also delivered with the CD of the Peniel, the prayer calendar and other materials.

During this time, the luggage team must have uploaded each baggage on the bus to be ready to go out to church.

The Farewell prayer is made by reminding them that the next thing is to immediately begin school of life from the H2Groups.
